Town of Hatfield Residents Get Basketball Court & Park

Hatfield, MA – Residents in the Town of Hatfield were pleased when they learned that a plan for a community project was going to build a new park on the site of a former school in the center of town. The news got even better when the project received a significant boost from a donation from All States Materials Group (ASMG) of Sunderland.

The initial plans for the park included removing an old basketball court that had become unsafe, leveling the land, and building a new court on the site.
