Position Summary:

This is an entry level Lab Technician position that requires the individual to safely test and inspect road construction materials to determine whether or not their characteristics, properties and quality meet or exceed the standards and specifications required by our customers under close supervision of the Lab Staff/ Lab Manager.

Essential Functions:

- Adheres to all safety rules and works safely on all tasks.
- Ability to work with other members of the team and communicate effectively and efficiently with QC personnel, terminal operators and the operations manager.
- Perform testing in accordance with ASMG's quality control system and other applicable standards such as ASTM and AASHTO.
- Testing and inspection of road construction materials, specifically liquid asphalt products including asphalt binder, cutback, emulsion sealants and others.
- Develop a working knowledge of product specification compliance for all applicable liquid products.
- Document results accurately, reporting will be organized, accurate and completed in a timely manner.
- Maintain a clean and organized work area
- Analysis of test data to prevent non-conforming products.
- Regular care of testing equipment.

Work Conditions

Primarily quality control lab environment, indoors. Limited outside/field exposure. Will take samples from storage tanks, in-line samplers.
