

TRANSPORT DRIVER

Company Summary:

All States Materials Group is a family of companies with over 300 employees throughout the greater Northeast. The company started in 1957 and has experienced steady growth, becoming a vertically-integrated liquid asphalt distributor, construction and paving company. The company values everyone in the workforce and frequently promotes our own employees. We have developed our own, on site CDL driver training program to train employees and potential employees how to drive tractor trailers. In order to be eligible for the driver training program you must have a strong desire to drive a truck, CDL permit/tanker endorsement, good driving record, medical card, be at least 21 years of age, and pass a drug test.

Position Summary:

Excellent opportunity to travel the greater Northeast region, working in the summer with winters off. The transport driver is responsible for the safe and responsible operation of a tractor trailer, picking up and delivering loads of asphalt to specific locations, and for properly loading and unloading material in a safe manner according to written procedures.

Essential Functions:

The following list is intended to be exemplary of the physical demands of the position; however, it is not exhaustive of all day-to-day functions. The incumbent will be required to perform any or all of the following in a given day or week:

1. Adheres to all safety rules and works safely on all jobs.
2. Safe operation of a tanker tractor trailer, weighing in excess of 100,000 pounds, when full.
3. Inspection of the operating condition of the tractor and trailer before, during and after delivery of cargo. Lifting, manipulating and twisting 3"x10' -15' hose weighing in excess of 40 pounds when empty. Each load will require the hooking and unhooking of the hoses twice, once during loading and again during unloading;
4. Drive 1500-2000 miles in a week, averaging two loads per day. Will need to inspect the underside of the vehicle and facilitate the loading and unloading of material;
5. While performing the duties of this position the incumbent is regularly required to sit, use hand to finger, handle or feel, reach with hands and arms, talk or hear, walk, climb stairs, ladders, & catwalks, stoop, bend, twist, kneel and crouch;
6. Report immediately to dispatch any damage to the equipment or safety hazards or accidents.
7. Must be able to consistently lift and/or manipulate with push/pull force +/- 50 pounds and climb up/ down ladder;
8. Flexibility with regard to schedule working extended hours, nights, weekends, and holidays when business needs dictate. Regional travel with crew requiring dependable transportation, occasional overnight travel.
