Position Summary:

The triaxle/dump truck driver is responsible for performing duties related to Paving/Construction operation, and the safe and responsible operation of all applicable machinery and equipment.

Essential Functions:

The following list is intended to be exemplary of the physical demands of the position however it is not exhaustive of all day-to-day functions. The incumbent will be required to perform any or all of the following in a given day or week:

1. Adheres to all safety rules and works safely on all jobs.
2. Ability to work with other members of the crew and communicate effectively and efficiently.
3. Requires perceptual skill to monitor a sometimes complex driving situation, the judgment skills to make quick decisions when necessary, manipulative skill to control an oversize steering wheel, shift gears using a manual transmission, and maneuver the truck in crowded areas. Ability to load under asphalt plant as well as back up to a paver safely and dump;
4. Report immediately to foreman any damage to the equipment or safety hazards or accidents.
5. Must be able to consistently lift and/or manipulate with push/pull force +/- 50 pounds;
6. Flexibility with regard to schedule, working extended hours, nights, weekends, and holidays when business needs dictate.

Work Conditions

Candidate must be able to tolerate moderate to loud noise level (PPE will be provided, including hearing protection as required), long hours standing, sitting and driving outdoors in varying weather and road conditions.

Other Accountabilities/Responsibilities:

Perform related and unrelated duties as may be required.

Position Requirements:

1. 3-5 years of prior industry experience.
2. Ability to work as part of a team
3. Ability to pass a DOT physical and drug screen.
4. Must have a valid Class B CDL license and clean driving record.
5. Must possess sound judgment, and ability to analyze MSDS sheets.
