

While fueling equipment, the following procedures must be followed:

- Turn off vehicle ignition.
- Place vehicle in gear and engage brake. (If applicable)
- No smoking, open flames, or other sources of ignition within 25 feet of fuel.
- Note the location of fire extinguishers.
- Do not cause spillage of any amount.
- Do not leave the nozzle unattended while fueling.
- Do not fully top up the fuel tank.
- Put the nozzle and hose back in the proper place.



Filling Equipment

Our company firmly believes in protecting the environment from materials that would endanger wildlife. To prevent polluting the groundwater and streams of our communities, the following safe work practices must be followed:

- Report all leaks as soon as possible.
- If a vehicle or piece of machinery leaks diesel, contain the spill using proper spill control procedures.
- Never fill equipment near waterways.
- Never fill on asphalt.
- Never fill where a source of ignition is present.
- Guard against over-filling.
